

General Pool Rules

BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE Members co-operation in following pool rules is important for the enjoyment of the pool by all.

COMMITMENT We believe that swimming is a healthy activity that promotes physical activity and healthy living. Members, volunteers and lifeguards involved in our organization have a responsibility to model safe swimming behaviours.

POOL RULES

1. OBEY ALL LIFEGUARDS (their decision is final). Direct concerns to Pool Manager.
2. WHEN THE LIFEGUARD BLOWS THE WHISTLE – CLEAR THE POOL.
3. Swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
4. Members/Guests must wear appropriate attire for a public/family setting.
5. Guests are unable to stay at the pool after the member leaves.
6. NO RUNNING, BOISTEROUS PLAY, OR PROFANITY will be tolerated.
7. DIVING IS ONLY ALLOWED FROM THE SAME EDGE AS THE DIVING BOARD.
8. No swimming under or in front of the diving board.
9. Water toys may be used responsibly with the Lifeguard's discretion for safety.
10. NO SMOKING or ALCOHOL on pool premises. If considered under the influence, you may be asked to leave the pool premises.
11. No food, drinks, or chairs within three feet of the pool's edge.
12. No dogs, cats or other animals allowed on pool premises.
13. Placing notices or use of the Member email list may not be used without Board's approval.
14. For the safety of all members, limiting the numbers of bathers to 90 is necessary. Swim time may be limited to ensure everyone has an opportunity to enjoy the pool.
15. Family membership is non transferable.

WHEN CAN CHILDREN ATTEND THE POOL WITHOUT AN ADULT? As a general guideline, children must be at least 10 years of age. If the lifeguard is not pleased with the child's behavior, the child(ren) will be asked to leave and must be accompanied by an adult for future visits to the pool.
